Leviticus 23:40 - And ye shall take you on the first day the boughs of goodly trees, branches of palm trees, and the boughs of thick trees, and willows of the brook; and ye shall rejoice before the Lord your God seven days.

<i>Etog</i>	<i>Small Lemon-type Fruit</i>	<i>Beautiful Trees</i>	<i>This branch was held in the left hand. As in the Ancient Temple services, the branches are held while the Hosanna verse is chanted. (Psalms 118:25)</i>	<i>Type of the beauty and glory of the Lord Jesus. When we abide in Him we will produce fruit. (John 15:1-5)</i>
<i>Lulav</i>	<i>Long Branch of a Date Palm</i>	<i>Palm Trees</i>	<i>Held in the Right Hand in a Bundle</i>	<i>Type of Christ's Strength and Power to Save. The people chanted, "Save Now" and waved these as the Messiah came into Jerusalem.</i>
<i>Hadas</i>	<i>None but has Tiny Leaves</i>	<i>Myrtle Tree</i>	<i>Three myrtle trees were</i>	<i>Type of praise - they waved</i>

			<i>held in the right hand along with the date palm.</i>	<i>these during the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem before His passion.</i>
<i>Arava</i>	<i>None</i>	<i>Willows of the Brook</i>	<i>Usually two willows are held in the right hand since the Bible mentions them in the plural. Held with the date palm and myrtle tree.</i>	<i>Type of Christ's humility. These willows were easily broken and bruised. Christ the Suffering Servant.</i>
